EFL TEACHER ROSSALL SUMMER SCHOOL 2012



TEFL people are required to join a residential teaching team at Rossall Summer School during the eight weeks from 7th July to the 1st September 2012. Rossall is a distinguished independent school with over 650 boarding and day pupils set in 160 acres nestled on the picturesque Lancashire coastline. Details of the job are as follows:

Reporting relationships

The teachers will be part of a team of EFL Teachers and Activity Staff headed by the Directors of the Summer School

Job objective

To engage the students in enjoyable productive language lessons to improve their English and to be involved in some of the extra-curricular activities and excursions thereby contributing to an exciting all round experience for the students each week.

Specific Responsibilities

- EFL Teachers will be expected to teach twenty classroom hours per week. There are 4 lessons per day. The first two lessons focus on grammar and writing, reading and listening. The third lesson is focused on speaking to develop confidence and fluency. The fourth lesson is project work. All of the lessons are based around a syllabus which is divided into weeks. Each week is based around a theme and we use the major EFL textbooks which are on the market at the moment.
- Teachers are encouraged to live on campus. Accommodation and meals are provided free of charge
- Teachers will be expected to be involved on a rota basis in some of the busy weekday and evening activities and the Sunday excursion programme.
- Teachers will be asked to provide pastoral care for the students overnight on a duty rota basis
