Rossall Nursery is situated in a modern, purpose-built premises on the site of Rossall School. We are a friendly bunch and have lots of fun, whilst encouraging a stimulating learning environment for all children aged 2-4.

Nursery School Day

The Nursery is open for fifty weeks of the year excluding all Bank Holidays. The day is divided into two sessions, morning and afternoon with lunch being considered as part of the morning session.

The Morning Session runs from 8.00am - 12.00 noon.

The Afternoon Session runs from 1.00pm - 5.00pm.

Lunch is optional from 12.00 noon—1.00pm.

After school club runs from 5.00pm—6.00pm.

Starting with a minimum of three sessions per week to begin with, upon reaching the age of 3 we recommend at least 5 sessions per week to enable your child to experience the full range of activities. We offer either a 40 week or 50 week option, please ask for further details.

Nursery Curriculum

Early Years Foundation Stage

This curriculum is designed to provide children with the support needed to extend their knowledge, skills, understanding and confidence. We seek to provide children with a rich and stimulating environment where they feel included, secure and valued. We follow four guiding themes: a unique child, positive relationships, enabling environments, learning and development.

International Baccalaureate Primary Years Programme (age 3 to 7)

An international curriculum designed to foster the development of the whole child through all means of learning. Each topic or "Unit of Inquiry" is research based and leads to more collaboration between the pupils e.g. group investigations. This curriculum continues through into Rossall Junior School.

Working in Partnerships with Parents and Carers

Our aim is to provide the highest standard of education and care for each child. We recognise the importance of a good partnership between staff and parents, and endeavour to keep parents and carers well informed of each child's progress.
