

Infant & Nursery Clubs and Activities

Monday

- 3.00pm **Nursery Jazz and Ballet** are ideal practical activities to encourage co-ordination, balance and rhythm. There is an opportunity to work towards examinations.
- 3.20pm **Violin Club Year 1, Year 2 Girls** an opportunity for pupils to learn to play the violin and read music. Individual and group performances will be given during concerts.
- 3.30pm **Reception, Year 1, Year 2 Boys Jazz Club** gives the boys an opportunity to experience movement to music and to work towards preliminarily examinations.

Tuesday

- 1.00pm **Ball Games** encourages children to improve their catching and throwing skills at the same time as working on hand eye co ordination whilst playing fun games.
- 3.20pm **Violin Club Year 1, Year 2 Boys** an opportunity for pupils to learn to play the violin and read music. Individual and group performances will be given during concerts.
- 3.20pm **Reception, Year 1, Year 2 Girls Ballet** offers an introduction to ballet following a structured programme. Examinations may be taken at various stages of the course.

- 3.20pm **Boomwhacker Bells.** The children learn to play simple melodies on boomwakers in a group, accompanied by a piano.

Thursday

- 3.20pm **Sewing Club.** The children make a variety of items, including pin cushions and puppets. They will learn to use needle and thread safely and concentrate on their hand eye co ordination skills.
